N.0*02'W., bet. secs. 14 and 15.

Ascend 87 ft. over SW. slope, through timber and brush.

6.00 Glen Echo Branch of the Calf Creek Way Trail, bears E. and W.

6.40 Spur, slopes W.

Descend 565 ft. over broken N. slope.

17.60 Limpy Creek, 15 lks. wide, course NW., from the S.

24.50 Leave Limpy Creek, course NW., from the S.

26.00 North Umpqua River, 180 lks. wide, course NW.

Ascend 50 ft. over SW. slope.

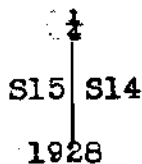
35.90 Small spur, slopes W.

Descend 20 ft. over NW. slope.

37.90 Apple Creek, dry, course SW.

Ascend 60 ft. over SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock, supported in a mound of stone, with a 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap marked,

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.46*E., 126 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 14 B T.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.55*W., 66 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 B T.

Ascend 540 ft. over SW. slope.

40.25 North Umpqua River Trail, bears N.70*E., and S.70*W., and forest service telephone line.

59.60 Small spur, slopes W., Descend 70 ft. over NW. slope.

67.50 Draw, course W.

Ascend 220 ft. over SW. slope.

74.80 Spur, slopes W.

Descend 30 ft. over NW. slope.
