19.30 Draw, course NW.

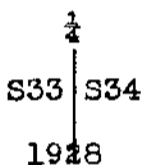
28.70 Enter West Limpy Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. from the SW.

33.70 Leave West Limpy Creek, course N.30*E.

35.40 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S.75*E.

57.10 Draw, course S.65*E.

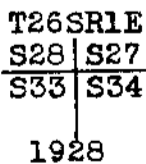
66.50 Spur, slopes E.
