Descend 34 ft. over NW. slope.

43.40 West Limpy Creek, 8 lks. wide, course N.60*E.

Ascend 800 ft. over broken E. slope.

64.90 Draw, course SE.

70.20 Small draw, course N.75*E.

79.90 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, loam, third rate.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock and pine.

Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

N.0*02*W., bet. secs. 27 and 28;

Over mountainous land, through timber and brush.

Ascend 50 ft. over S. slope.

1.90 Spur, slopes S.20*E.

Descend 30 ft. over NE. slope.

8.00 Draw, course E.

Ascend 60 ft. over SE. slope.

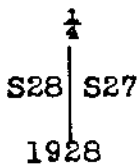
12.20 Spur, slopes NE.

Descend 640 ft. over broken N. slope.

21.20 Draw, course N.10*E. Slope changing to NE.

30.10 Small draw, course NE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked,
