Descend 90 ft. over NW. slope.

50.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.30\*E.

Ascend 570 ft. over broken E. slope.

56.90 Spur, slopes N.30\*E.

65.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.60\*E.

79.88 The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam, third rate.

Timber, fir and pine.

Undergrowth, vine maple and second growth timber.

N.0\*02\*W., bet. secs. 9 and 10.

Ascend 70 ft. over SE. slope, through timber and brush.

4.90 Spur, slopes E.

Descend 223 ft. over broken NE. slope.

9.00 Enter old burned over area, bears E. and W.

16.10 Draw, course N.70\*E.

17.30 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.70\*E.

19.10 Small spur, slopes NE.

23.00 Draw, course NE.

29.00 Spur, slopes NE.

34.60 Draw, course NE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked
