A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N.36*W., 69 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 4 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam, third rate.

Timber, fir, pine and yew.

Undergrowth, vine maple.

N.89*58'E., on a random line bet. secs. 3 and 10.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 Intersect the N. and S. line, 21 lks. S. of the cor. of
secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Thence,

S.89*49'W., on a true line bet. secs. 3 and 10.

Descend 60 ft. over W. slope, through timber and brush.

3.20 Jackass Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S.20*W.

Ascend 120 ft. over SE. slope.

21.70 Spur, slopes S.

Descend 62 ft. over SW. slope.

28.30 Draw, course S.20*E.

Ascend 115 ft. over SE. slope.

34.60 Spur, slopes S.

Descend 82 ft. over SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked,
