CHAINS

Descend 38 ft. over SW. slope, through timber and brush.

7.20 Draw, course S.15*E.

Ascend 316 ft. over SE. slope.

19.20 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.

Descend 76 ft. over NW. slope.

23.20 Draw, course NW.

Ascend 150 ft. over a series of bluffs and slide rock on NE. slope.

32.80 Rocky point of spur, slopes N.

Descend 395 ft. over NW. slope.

39.79 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked,

46.70 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course N.

Ascend 360 ft. over NE. slope.

58.50 Spur, slopes N.15*E.

Descend 357 ft. over broken NW. slope.

63.30 Small draw, course N.15*E.

72.10 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.

Ascend 87 ft. over NE. slope.

75.20 Small spur, slopes NE.

Descend 43 ft. over NW. slope.

79.58 The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam, third rate.
