80.08 Intersect N. and S. line, 2 lks. S. of the cor. of secs.  
 3, 4, 9 and 10.

S.89\*56'W., on a true line bet. secs. 4 and 9.

Over mountainous land, through timber and brush.

Descend 210 ft. over bluffs on SW. slope.

10.70 Red Man's Creek, 4 lks. wide, course SW.

Ascend 40 ft. over SE. slope.

11.60 Spur, slopes S.

Descend 144 ft. over SW. slope.

16.50 North Umpqua Trail and forest service telephone line,  
 bears SE. and NW.

18.00 North bank of North Umpqua River, 180 lks. wide, course NW.

22.10 South Bank of river.

Ascend 510 ft. over broken NE. slope.

26.90 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course NE.
