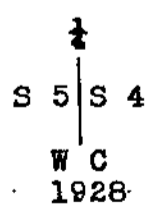

CHAINS

- 47.68 Foot trail, SE. to cable car bridge, and NW. to a junction with the Panther Creek Way Trail.
- 47.70 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.
- 49.05 Panther Creek Way Trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 71.00 Spur, slopes NE.
Descend 30 ft. over NW. slope.
- 74.10 Head of draw, course NE.
- 80.08 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.
Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky, third rate.
Timber, fir and hemlock.
Undergrowth, vine maple and grease wood.

N.0°03'W., on a random line bet. secs. 4 and 5.

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.
- 80.04 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp., 35 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, hereinbefore described.
Thence,
S.0°18'E., on a true line bet. secs. 4 and 5.
Over mountainous land, through timber and brush.
Descend 1000 ft. over broken S. slope.
- 31.60 Draw, course SE.
- 38.10 North Umpqua River Trail and forest service telephone line, bears NW. and SE.
- 38.86 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the witness $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked,
