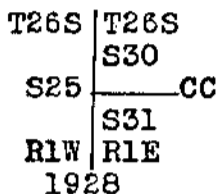


Subdivisions, T. 26 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

At point of intersection;

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap marked,



from which

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.73*E., 20 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 30 C C B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.45*E., 28 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 31 C C B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam, third rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, pine, yew and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

From the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Thence,

N.0*04'W., bet. secs. 29 and 30.

Descend 200 ft. over broken NE. slope, through timber and brush.

2.90 Draw, course N.70*E.

13.60 Draw, course N.65*E.

Ascend 40 ft. over SE. slope.

22.50 Small spur, slopes N.80*E.

Descend 320 ft. over N. slope.

34.60 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course N.75*E.

Ascend 20 ft. over broken SE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked,
