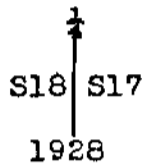


Subdivisions, T. 26 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

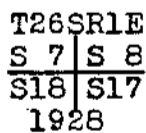
- 25.90 Spur, slopes E.
Descend 70 ft. over NE. slope.
- 31.40 Dry creek bed, 3 lks. wide, course S.70*E.
Ascend 195 ft. over S. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked,



from which

- A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 35 lks. dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 B T.
- A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S.85*W., 25 lks. dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T.

- 42.00 Spur, slopes S.60*E.
Descend 60 ft. over NE. slope.
- 44.10 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE.
Ascend 340 ft. over S. slope.
- 62.62 Cougar Creek Trail, bears E. and W.
- 66.60 Ridge, bears E. and W.
Descend 40 ft. over N. slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, for the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18, with
brass cap marked,



from which

- A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.39*E., 101 lks. dist.
Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 8 B T.
- A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.68*E., 49 lks. dist.
Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 17 B T.
