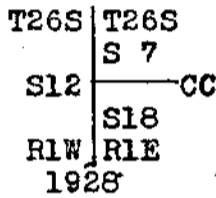


County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Subdivisions, T. 26 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

Descend 450 ft. over a series of bluffs on W. slope.
 61.50 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.
 Ascend 230 ft. over E. slope.
 74.02 Intersect the Willamette Meridian, 6.85 chs. N.0°51'E.,
 of the cor. of secs. 12 and 13 only, hereinbefore
 described.
 At point of intersection;
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in
 the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with
 brass cap marked,



from which

- A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.42°E., 119 lks. dist.
 Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 7 C C B T.
- A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.31°E., 39 lks. dist.
 Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 18 C C B T.

Land, mountainous.
 Soil, rocky loam, third rate.
 Timber, fir.
 Undergrowth, vine maple and greasewood.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18.
 Thence,
 N.0°04'W., bet. secs. 7 and 8.
 Ascend 10 ft. over S. slope, through timber and brush.
 14.00 Top of ridge, bears N. and S.10°W.,
 Descend 160 ft. over gradual N. slope, along top of
 ridge.
 35.00 N. end of ridge, divides into two spurs, one bears NE.
 and the other bears NW.
