- A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.32\*W., 63 lks.  
dist., mkd. T 26 S R 2 E S 36 B T
- A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.56\*W., 60 lks.  
dist., mkd. T 26 S R 2 E S 25 B T

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

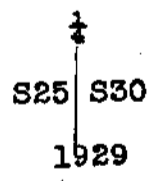
Timber; fir, yew, hemlock, cedar, and madrona.

Undergrowth; vinemaple, hazel, rhododendron, and arrow-wood.

North bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Desc. 60 ft. over bluff, facing NW., through medium timber and dense undergrowth.

- 5.30 Draw, course W., asc. 60 ft. over bluff facing SW.,
- 14.00 Top of bluffs, thence over nearly level land, across Oak Flats.
- 30.50 North Umpqua Trail, and telephone line, bears NW. and SE.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30, with brass cap marked
