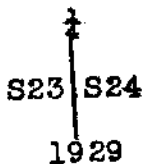


## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

## Subdivisions of T. 26 S., R. 2 E.

## CHAINS

- 80.48 Cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26  
Land; rough mountainous and bench.  
Soil; rocky, 4th rate.  
Timber; pine, fir, oak, cedar, yew, and hemlock.  
Undergrowth; vinemapple, small pine and fir, rhododendron,  
hazel, and arrow-wood.

- N.0\*01'W., bet. secs. 23 and 24.  
Desc. 216 ft. over rocky NE. slope, through heavy  
timber and medium undergrowth.
- 5.00 Copeland Creek, 30 lks. wide, course NW., asc. 732 ft.  
over SW. slope, over loose rocks and bluffs.
- 24.00 Top of rim, 170 ft. high, bears NW. 5.00 chs., thence  
NE., and SE., asc. 25 ft. over SE. slope.
- 25.20 North Umpqua Trail and telephone line, bears NW. and SE.
- 27.10 Spur, W. point of Oak Flats, slopes W., desc. 410 ft.  
over NW. slope.
- 30.00 North Umpqua Trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 34.00 North Umpqua Trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 36.00 Same trail, bears NE. and SW.,
- 36.40 Same trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in  
the ground, to bed rock, and in mound of stone,  
2½ ft. base, for ¼ sec. cor. of secs, 23 and 24, with  
brass cap mkd.
