- 60.30 Spur, slopes NE., Twin Lakes Trail, along top, bears SW. and NE., desc. 513 ft. over broken NW. slope, to cor.
- 70.00 Draw, course N., from SW., down draw.
- 73.40 Leave draw, course NW.
- 78.40 Spur, slopes NW.,
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, with brass cap mkd.
