A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S.35*E., 54 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 B T

Over nearly level land.

- 44.60 Intersect NE. cor. of barn.
- 45.50 Twin Lakes Trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 45.90 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N., enter hay field, bears
NE. and SW.
- 48.70 NE. cor. of house bears S.23*E., 203 lks. dist.
- 50.40 Leave hay field bears NW. and SE., through scattering
timber and dense undergrowth.
- 51.20 Hole-in-the-Ground Trail, bears NW. and SE., asc. 20
ft. over NE. slope.
- 54.70 Spur, slopes N., along gradual N. slope.
- 57.70 SW. cor. of house, under construction, bears N.11*E.,
222 lks. dist., desc. 205 ft. over broken NW. slope,
through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.
- 66.46 Intersect line bet. cors. Nos. 6 and 7, H. E. S. No.229
cor. No. 6 bears S.25*16'E., 20.40 chs. dist.
- 74.10 Hole-in-the-Ground Trail, bears S. and NE.,
- 78.50 Wilson Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N., asc. 60 ft. over
E. slope.
- 79.90 Cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, pine and yew.

Undergrowth; vinemaple, rhododendron, hazel, and
arrow-wood.
