N.0\*02\*W., bet. secs. 22 and 23.

Desc. 170 ft. over NE. slope, through scattering timber and medium undergrowth.

4.20 Wilson Creek, dry, course NW., asc. 204 ft. over SW. slope.

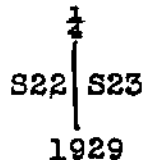
10.50 Top of ascent, bears NW. and SE., thence over nearly level bench.

26.10 Desc. 80 ft. over NW. slope.

30.10 Steep, rocky, draw, course NW., asc. 12 ft. along bluff.

33.50 Rim, 150 ft. high, bears NE. and SW., desc. 420 ft. over bluffs, facing NW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 23, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.45\*E., 41 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 23 B T

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.62\*W., 17 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 22 B T

Desc. 262 ft. over NW. slope, through medium timber and dense undergrowth.

46.50 Left bank of North Umpqua River, course S.55\*W.,

51.30 Right bank of river, asc. 692 ft. over broken SE. slope.

63.80 North Umpqua River Trail, and telephone line, bears NE. and SW.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, with brass cap mkd.
