40.00 Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.

80.30 Intersect N. bdy. of Tp. 7 lks. W. of cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, hereinbefore described

Thence

S.0*14'E., on true line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Asc. 32 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

4.00 Spur, slopes E., desc. 180 ft. over SE. slope.

9.00 Draw, course SE., asc. 44 ft. over NE. slope.

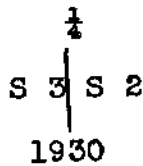
12.00 Spur, slopes E., desc. 95 ft. over SE. slope.

16.30 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course E., asc. 300 ft. over NE. slope.

24.00 Spur, slopes NE., desc. 47 ft. over SE. slope.

29.40 Draw, course NE., asc. 374 ft. over NE. slope.

40.30 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 4 ins. in the ground, to bed rock, and in mound of stone, 5 ft. base, for 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd.

42.00 Spur, slopes NE., desc. 330 ft. over SE. slope.

49.40 Draw, course SE., asc. 200 ft. over NE. slope.

63.50 Rattlesnake Ridge, bears SE. and NW., desc. 470 ft. over SW. slope.
