- 72.80 Grassy Ranch Trail bears NE. and SW.
- 73.90 Forest Service telephone line bears NE. and SW.
- 75.67 Intersect line bet. cors. Nos. 1 and 4, H. E. S. No. 227;
cor. No. 4 bears N.50*25'E., 6.37 chs. dist.
- 76.00 Enter cultivated field, bears N.30*E., and S.70*W.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 29 ins. in
the ground, for cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, with
brass cap mkd.
