63.30 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 40 ft. over SW. slope.

65.50 Draw, course SE., asc. 130 ft. over NE. slope.

74.00 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 81 ft. over SW. slope.

76.90 Draw, course SE., asc. 135 ft. over E. slope.

80.34 Cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, yew, alder, Oregon maple, and chinquapin.

Undergrowth; vinemaple, mountain laurel, hazel, buck brush, huckleberry, manzanita, gooseberry, and arrow-wood.

N.0*15'W., on random line, bet. secs. 3 and 4.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.21 Intersect N. bdy. of Tp., 40 lks. N.89*52'W., of point for cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34.

Thence

S.0*02'W., on true line, bet. secs. 3 and 4.

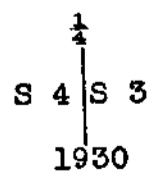
Asc. 24 ft. along broken W. slope, through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

0.42 Intersect witness cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, hereinbefore described.

24.70 Ragged Ridge, bears E. and W., way trail along ridge, desc. 145 ft. over S. slope.

33.10 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 305 ft. over SW. slope.

40.21 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap mkd.
