mkd. T 26 S R 2 E S 17 B T

Land; mountainous.

Soil; cleared land; mountain loam, 3rd rate, balance
rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, oak, cedar, and madrona.

Undergrowth; vinemaple, hazel, arrow-wood, scrub oak,
and dogwood.

S.89*49'E., on random line bet. secs. 16 and 21.

40.00 Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.

80.40 Intersect N. and S. line, 12 lks. S. of cor. of secs. 15,
16, 21, and 22, hereinbefore described.

Thence

N.89*54'W., on true line bet. secs. 16 and 21.

Along gradual S. slope, across cleared field.

3.26 Intersect line bet. cors. Nos. 1 and 2, H. E. S. No.227;
cor. No. 1 bears S.6*21'W., 7.73 chs. dist.

3.50 Farm road, bears NW. and SE.

10.00 Leave field, enter medium timber and medium undergrowth
bears N. and S.

33.26 Intersect line bet. cors. Nos. 3 and 4; H. E. S. No. 142;
cor. No. 3 bears N.14*47'W., 11.52 chs. dist.

33.90 Low spur, slopes S.

36.90 Small draw, course S.,

40.20 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21, with
brass cap mkd.
