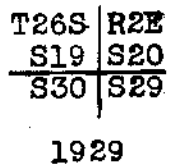

Spur, slopes W., desc. 623 ft. over broken NW. slope.
Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW., asc. 64 ft. over SW. slope.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground, for cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30,
with brass cap mkd.

Undergrowth; small fir, vinempalè, arrow-wood, hazel,
and rhododendron.
