CHAINS

Asc. 62 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 1.80 Spur, slopes N.10*E., desc. 72 ft. over NW. slope.
- 5.30 Draw, course N., asc. 38 ft. over NE. slope.
- 9.60 Spur, slopes N., along N. slope.
- 17.60 Draw, course N.30*E., asc. 196 ft. over NE. slope.
- 23.80 Spur, slopes N.30*E., desc. 111 ft. over NW. slope.
- 32.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N., asc. 142 ft. over NE. slope.
- 39.93 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 29, with brass cap mkd:

- 64.60 Spur, slopes N., desc. 532 ft. over broken NW. slope.
- 71.40 Head of draw, course NW.,
- 75.30 Spur, slopes N.25*W.,
- 79.86 Cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky mountain loam, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, pine, cedar, hemlock, and yew.

Undergrowth; small fir, vinemaple, arrow-wood, hazel, rhododendron, and goose berry.
