76.89 Intersect line bet. cors. Nos. 1 and 4, H. E. S. No. 182;
cor. No. 1 bears S.1*31'W., 3.35 chs. dist.

79.77 Cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky mountain loam, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, pine, oak and Oregon maple.

Undergrowth; scrub oak, hazel, small fir, mountain laurel,
willow, chinquapin, manzanita, vinemaple, sarvis berry
and dog wood.

N.0*04'W., bet. secs. 17 and 18.

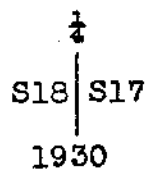
Desc. 66 ft. over NE. slope, through medium timber and
dense undergrowth.

4.20 Draw, course E., asc. 119 ft. over SE. slope.

6.80 Spur, slopes E., along broken E. slope.

14.40 Draw, small stream, course NE., asc. 610 ft. over S.,
changing to SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 18, with
brass cap mkd.

A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S.41*W., 93 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T

45.00 Way trail, bears N.20*W., and S.20*E.

49.40 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 33 ft. along NE. slope.

55.40 Head of draw, course E., asc. 107 ft. along SE. slope.

62.40 Ridge, bears N.15*E., and S.15*W., way trail along top.
