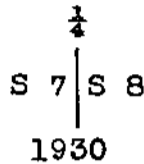


Subdivisions of T. 26 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

38.50 Ridge, bears NW. and SE., trail along top.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 8, with brass cap mkd.



from which,

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.61*E., 49 lks. dist.,

Mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 8 B T

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.44*W., 49 lks. dist.,

Mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 7 B T

Along broken E. slope.

50.00 Head of draw, course E.,

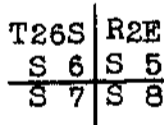
56.00 Asc. 185 ft. over SE. slope.

64.30 Way trail, bears NE. and SW.

64.60 Ridge, bears NE. and SW., desc. 126 ft. over broken NW. slope.

77.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW., asc. 80 ft. over SE. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8, with Brass cap mkd.

A cedar, 50 ins. diam., bears N.6*E., 113 lks. dist.,

mkd. T 26 S R 2 E S 5 B T

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 45 lks. dist.,

mkd. T 26 S R 2 E S 8 B T

A cross (X) on a boulder, in place, 14x12x30 ft.

above ground, bears S.56*W., 129 lks. dist.,

boulder marked S 7 B O X
