43.80	Spur, slopes SE., desc. 366 ft. over broken SW. slope.
51.50	Draw, course SW.,
56.30	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S., asc. 272 ft. over SE. slope.
69.60	Ridge bears N. and S., trail along top, desc. 275 ft. over NW. slope.
77.30	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW., asc. 40 ft. over SE. slope.
79.78	Cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8. Land; mountainous. Soil; rocky, 4th rate. Timber; fir, cedar, pine, hemlock, yew, alder and madrona. Undergrowth; vinemaple, rhododendron, huckle berry, buck brush, arrow-wood, and hazel.
40.00	S.89*54'W., on a random line bet. secs. 6 and 7, Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.30	Intersect W. bdy. of Tp., 16 lks. S. of cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, as described in the field notes of T. 26 S., R. 1 E., this Group. Thence S.89*59'E., on true line bet. secs. 6 and 7 Desc. 318 ft. over broken SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

19.50	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE., asc. 110 ft. over SW. slope.
27.10	Spur, slopes S., desc. 22 ft. over SE. slope.
32.30	Draw, course S., asc. 16 ft. over SW. slope.
35.50	Spur, slopes SW., desc. 77 ft. over SE. slope.
39.50	Draw, course SE., along S. slope.
