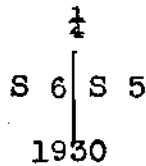


Subdivisions of T. 26 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

- 5.60 Spur, slopes NE., desc. 30 ft. over gradual SE. slope.
- 9.70 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE., asc. 353 ft. over broken NE., changing to N. slope.
- 32.50 Spur, slopes NW., desc. 10 ft. over SW. slope.
- 35.40 Draw course NW., asc. 63 ft. over NE. slope.
- 40.19 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 5, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.41*E., 78 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 B T

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.33*W., 46 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 B T.

Asc. 64 ft. over NE. slope.

- 46.30 Ragged Ridge, bears E. and W., trail along top, desc. 274 ft. over SE. changing to S. slope.
- 58.00 Draw, course SE., desc. 257 ft. over SE. slope.
- 67.60 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW., asc. 77 ft. over NW. slope.
- 72.80 Spur, slopes SW., desc. 151 ft. over SE. slope.
- 80.19 Cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.
Land; mountainous.
Soil; rocky, 4th rate.
Timber; fir, cedar, pine, hemlock, and madrona, chinquapin and dogwood.
Undergrowth; vinemaple, rhododendron,, buck brush, hazel, arrow-wood, and huckle berry.
