- 42.50 Point of spur, slopes NW., desc. 84 ft. along broken NW. slope.
- 51.00 Foot of descent bears NE. and SW., thence over nearly level river land.
- 66.00 Left bank of North Umpqua River, course SW.
- 66.80 Right bank of river, asc. 200 ft. over SE. slope.
- 71.60 Mountain Meadow Trail and forest service telephone line bears NE. and SW.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, with brass cap mkd.
