

East Boundary of T. 26 S., R. 3 E.

CHAINS

Land; mountainous.
 Soil; mountain loam, 3rd rate.
 Timber; fir, cedar, hemlock, and yew.
 Undergrowth; young fir, mountain laurel, vinemaple,
 and rhododendron.

North Bdy. of T. 26 S., R. 3 E.

From the cor. of Tps. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 26 S., Rs. 3 and 4 E., west on random, at intervals of 40.00 chs., setting temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. and sec. cors. along the line bet. Tps. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 26 S., R. 3 E. At 479.06 chs. the parallel intersects a N. and S. line 29 lks. S. of the cor. of Tps. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 26 S., Rs. 2 and 3 E. The correction is 4.8 lks. N. per mile, counting from point of beginning.

Thence

S.89°58'E., bet. secs. 6 and 31, marking and blazing the true line.

Asc. 32 ft. over SW. slope, through medium timber and dense undergrowth.

- 1.70 Spur, slopes SE., way trail bears NW. and SE., desc. 529 ft. over E. slope.
- 17.20 Draw, course SE., along broken S. slope.
- 22.90 Draw, course S., asc. 170 ft. over SW. slope.
- 36.00 Spur, slopes S., desc. 28 ft. over SE. slope.
- 39.06 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
