

Subdivisions of T. 26 S., R. 3 E.

CHAINS

Timber; fir, cedar, pine and chinquapin.
Undergrowth; rhododendron, chinquapin, and young fir and pine.

S.89°42'E., on a random line bet. secs. 12 and 13.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.18 Intersect E. bdy. of Tp. 2 lks. S. of cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18.

Thence

N.89°43'W., on true line bet. secs. 12 and 13.

Asc. 37 ft. over NE. slope, through very dense undergrowth.

1.40 Ridge, bears N. and S., desc. 694 ft. over broken W., changing to SW. slope, to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

1.70 Enter heavy timber, bears N. and S.

22.50 Mountain Meadow Trail, and forest service telephone, line, bears S. and NE.

27.70 Draw, course SW.,

40.09 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 30 ins. diam., bears S.28°W., 39 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T

A fir, 49 ins. diam., bears N.50°W., 14 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 B T

Over rolling S. slope.

40.50 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.,

50.60 Mill Creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE., asc. 94 ft. over NE. slope.

58.00 Low spur, slopes N. desc, 25 ft. over gradual SW. slope.

65.00 Draw, course NE., from NW., asc. 114 ft. over NE. slope.

78.80 Ridge, bears N. and S., desc, 10 ft. over SW. slope.
