- 60.00 Way trail, bears E. and W.,
 68.40 Draw, course S.15*E., desc. 21 ft. along E. slope.
 80.16 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; mountain loam, 3rd rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, pine and cedar.

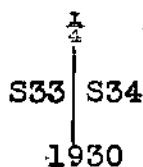
Undergrowth; young fir, rhododendron, vinemaple and
 arrow wood.

Thence from the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34 on the S.
 bdy. of Tp., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8
 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as
 described in the official record.

N.0*02'W., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Over nearly level bench land, through heavy timber and
 medium undergrowth.

- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in
