CHAINS

56.60 Fish Creek, 100 lks. wide, course NE., asc. 769 ft.  
over broken SE. slope, to cor.

65.70 Draw, course S.60°E.,

74.50 Spur, slopes SE.,

80.40 The cor. of sec. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, cedar, pine, hemlock, yew, maple, and  
madrona.

Undergrowth; vinemaple, rhododendron, and young fir.

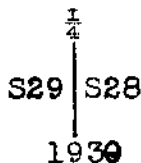
N.0°03'W., bet. secs. 28 and 29.

Asc. 140 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and  
dense undergrowth.

9.20 Along broken E. slope, rim of Fish Creek Canyon.

28.00 Spur, slopes NE., desc. 140 ft. over NE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 7 ins. in  
the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to  
top, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.40°E., 4 lks.  
dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 28 B T

A cross (X), on NE. face of rock, 10x6x4 ft. above  
ground, bears S.70°W., 26 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  X B O

Cor. on top of rock point, 70 ft. high, bears S.15°E.,  
and W. about 10 lks., thence NE.

Desc. 58 ft. along broken NE. slope, rim of canyon.

42.50 Draw, course E., asc. 130 ft. over S. slope.

45.30 Spur, slopes NE., desc. 140 ft. over NE., slope.

50.20 Draw, course E., asc. 138 ft. over S. slope.

53.50 Top of ascent, bears E. and W., over nearly level bench.
