44.00	Top of bluff 80 ft. high, facing W.,
44.20	Right bank of North Umpqua River, course NW.
45.30	Left bank of river, asc. 100 ft. over bluff, facing NE.,
46.00	Point of rocky spur, slopes N., desc. 100 ft. over bluff, facing NW.
47.00	Right bank of Fish Creek, course NE., 1.10 chs. to junction with river.
47.70	Left bank of creek, asc. 997 ft. over precipitous SE. slope.
70.00	Top of ascent, bears SW. and NE., about 2.00 chs., thence NW., over nearly level bench.
79.96	The cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29. Land; mountainous. Soil; rocky, 4th rate. Timber; fir, pine, cedar, hemlock, and yew. Undergrowth; rhododendron, vinemaple, and hazel.
