Asc. 355 ft. over S. slope.

43.40 Top of bluff, 130 ft. high, facing S., slope becomes gradual.

46.30 Bradley Trail, bears NE. and W.

52.10 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 32 ft. over NE. slope.

56.80 Draw, course SE., asc. 240 ft. over SW. slope.

66.10 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 130 ft. over NE. slope.
