<p>79.46</p>	<p>A pine, 30 ins. in dia., on line, marked with 2 notches on the W., and 2 notches on the E. sides.</p>
<p>79.96</p>	<p>The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky loam, 3rd rate. Timber, fir, hemlock and pine. Undergrowth, rhododendron, vine maple and chinquapin.</p>
