A fir, 12 ins. in dia., bears S.17\*E., 45 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 13 B T.

A fir, 6 ins. in dia., bears N.53\*W., 76 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 12 B T.

Ascend 360 ft. over broken E. slope.

71.90 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.

Descend 50 ft. over NW. slope.

79.76 The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine and hemlock.

Undergrowth, salal, chinquapin, rhododendron and maple.

N.0\*01\*W., bet. secs. 11 and 12.

Over mountainous land, through timber and brush.

Descend 246 ft. over NW. slope.

18.00 Draw, course W.

Ascend 40 ft. over S. slope.

20.30 Spur, slopes W.

Descend 286 ft. over broken N. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 27 ins. in  
the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked.

Descend 345 ft. over broken NW. slope.

46.60 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course W.

61.40 Creek, 3 lks. wide, from the SW., course N.

63.75 Leave same creek, course NW.

68.50 Creek, 8 lks. wide, course NE.

Ascend 269 ft. over broken S. slope.
