A fir, 14 ins. in dia., bears S.53\*E., 13 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 E S 34 B T

A fir, 12 ins. in dia., bears S.67\*W., 9 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 E S 33 B T

A fir, 24 ins. in dia., bears N.8\*W., 26 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 E S 28 B T

Land, rolling and mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron and second growth timber.

East, on a random line bet. secs. 27 and 34.
