26.90	Creek, 4 lks. wide, course NW.
28.60	Draw, course NE.
32.70	Draw, course SE.
40.00	A fir, 20 ins. in dia., for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 on N., and S 34 on S. sides. from which, A fir, 10 ins. in dia., bears S.15*W., 31 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 B T A fir, 18 ins. in dia., bears N.7*W., 27 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 B T.
42.60	Draw, course NE. Ascend 590 ft. over broken E. slope.
46.75	Red Butte Trail, and telephone line, bear NE. and SW.
57.90	Ridge, bears SE. and NW. Descend 476 ft. over broken W. slope.
72.30	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course NW.
78.49	Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course N.
80.00	The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34. Land, rolling and mountainous. Soil, rocky loam, 3rd rate. Timber, fir, pine and hemlock. Undergrowth, maple, alder and second growth timber.
	N.0*02'W., bet. secs. 27 and 28. Over mountainous land, through timber and brush.
1.90	Creek, 5 lks. wide, course NW.
12.30	Enter willow thicket, bears E. and W.
17.00	Leave willow thicket, bears E. and W., enter meadow. Ascend 160 ft. over gradual broken S. slope.
23.96	Red Butte Trail, bears NE. and W., leave meadow and enter timber, bears E. and W.
24.00	Telephone line, bears NE. and W.
