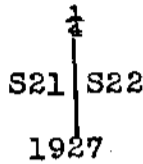


Subdivisions T. 27 S. R. 1 E.

CHAINS

- 11.20 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course W.
- 36.40 Small spur, slopes NW.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked



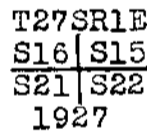
from which,

A fir, 8 ins. in dia., bears S.18\*E., 24 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 22 B T.

A hemlock, 6 ins. in dia., bears S.64\*W., 31 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 21 B T.

Descend 187 ft. over gradual broken N. slope.

- 66.40 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course NE.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, with brass cap marked.



from which,

A fir, 20 ins. in dia., bears N.84\*E., 9 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 E S 15 B T.

A cedar, 12 ins. in dia., bears S.33\*E., 20 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 E S 22 B T.

A hemlock, 20 ins. in dia., bears S.42\*W., 45 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 E S 21 B T.

A hemlock, 14 ins. in dia., bears N.40\*W., 15 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 E S 16 B T.

Land, rolling.

Soil, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, hemlock and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron and chinquapin.
