Over mountainous land, through timber and brush.

Ascend 32 ft. over SW. slope.

2.00 Spur, slopes W.

Descend 297 ft. over NW. slope.

6.90 Spur, slopes W.

15.80 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course W.

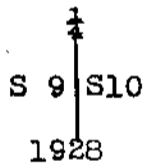
20.00 Creek, 6 lks. wide, course SW.

Ascend 400 ft. over S. slope.

33.60 Rocky spur, slopes SW.

Descend 160 ft. over NW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 27 ins. in
 the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked.

A fir, 40 ins. in dia., bears N.65*E., 31 lks. dist.,
 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 10 B T

A hemlock, 16 ins. in dia., bears S.15*W., 54 lks. dist.,
 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 B T

Ascend 208 ft. over broken S. slope.

41.20 Draw, course SW.

43.10 Same draw, course SE;

46.90 Same draw, course SW.

64.50 Divide, bears E. and W.
