60.44	Red Butte Trail, and telephone line, bears NE. and SW. Enter meadow.
61.20	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. Ascend 307 ft. over E. slope.
66.20	Leave meadow, bears SE. and NW., enter timber.
79.98	The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33. Land, rolling. Soil, rocky loam, 3rd rate. Timber, fir, hemlock and pine. Undergrowth, vine maple, chinquapin and second growth timber.
