47.30 Spur, slopes N.

48.37 North and South Trail, bears N. and S.

50.40 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course NW.

53.20 Spur, slopes N.

Descend 128 ft. over NW. slope.

61.70 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N.

Soil, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

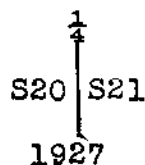
Timber, fir, hemlock, pine and cedar.
