CHAINS	N.89*53'E., on a random line bet. secs. 16 and 21.
40.00	Set temp, $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.08	Intersect the N. and S. line, 12 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22.
-	Thence, S.89*48'W., on a true line bet. secs. 16 and 21. Over rolling land, through timber and brush. Ascend 14 ft. over NE. slope.
1.10	Spur, slopes N. Descend 65 ft. over NW. slope.
13.00	Draw, course N. Ascend 12 ft. over NE. slope.
20.90	Small spur, slopes N. Descend 147 ft. over NW. slope.
