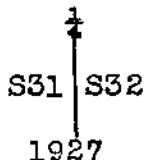

A hemlock, 24 ins. in dia., bears S.60*E., 66 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 B T

A hemlock, 22 ins. in dia., bears S.43*W., 59 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 31 B T

41.20 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW.

41.80 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course SW.

Ascend 123 ft. over S. slope.

61.80 Small spur, slopes W.

Descend 73 ft. over NW. slope.

67.40 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SW.

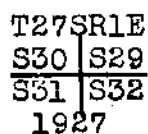
Ascend 45 ft. over S. slope.

71.30 Spur, slopes NW.

71.36 Flat Rock Way Trail, bears SE. and NW.

Descend 109 ft. over N. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 28 ins. in
the ground, for the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32,
with brass cap marked.

A hemlock 24 ins. in dia., bears S.81*W., 6 lks. dist.,
marked T 27 S R 1 E S 31 B T

A hemlock, 14 ins. in dia., bears N.64*W., 22 lks. dist.,
marked T 27 S R 1 E S 30 B T
