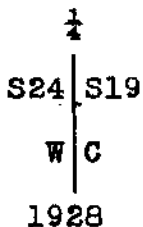


East Boundary of T. 27 S., R. 2 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for witness $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



from which,

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.18*E., 84 lks. dist., marked W C $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 B T.

A fir, 16, ins. diam., bears N.86*W., 91 lks. dist., marked W C $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 B T.

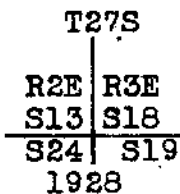
Ascend 860 ft. over broken S slope.

68.65 Top of ridge, bears N.70*W. and S.70*E.,
Way trail along top of ridge.

Descend 150 ft. over broken NE. slope.

75.50 Draw, course E.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, to bed rock, and mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, for the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, with brass cap marked



from which ,

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N26*E., 75 lks., dist., marked T 27 S R 3 E S 18 B T.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S19*E., 88 lks., dist., marked T 27 S R 3 E S 19 B T

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S.75*W., 137 lks., dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 24 B T.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.39*W., 63 lks., dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 13 B T.
