Over mountainous land, through heavy green timber,  
and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 12 ft. over SW. slope.

3.50 Spur, slopes NW.

Descend 650 ft. over broken NE. slope.

13.30 Way trail, bears NW. and SE.

27.90 Creek, 30 lks. wide, course NW.

Ascend 305 ft. over broken SW. slope.
