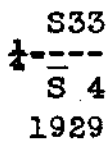

- A fir, 28 ins. in diam., bears N.63*E., 14 lks.
dist., marked T 26 S R 2 E S 34 B T
- A fir, 42 ins. in diam., bears S.13*E., 35 lks.
dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 3 B T
- A fir, 40 ins. in diam., bears S.41*W., 86 lks.
dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 4 B T
- A fir, 34 ins. in diam., bears N.61*W., 98 lks.
dist., marked T 26 S R 2 E S 33 B T

Land, mountainous.
Soil, loose, coarse rocky loam, 3rd rate.
Timber, fir, pine, cedar, hemlock, and yew.
Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron and chinquapin.

S.89*53'W., on a true line bet. secs. 4 and 33.
Over mountainous land, through timber and medium undergrowth.

- Ascend 100 ft. over NE. slope.
- 12.30 Top of spur, slopes NW.
- Descend 550 ft. over W. slope.
- 25.30 Enter meadow, bears N. and S.
- 28.30 Leave meadow, bears N. and S.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 iqs. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked



- from which,
- A pine, 9 ins. in diam., bears N.5*E., 43 lks.
dist., marked 1/4 S 33 B T
- A pine, 12 ins. in diam., bears S.58*W., 31 lks.
dist., marked 1/4 S 4 B T

- Descend 535 ft. over W. slope.
- 57.10 Falls on Deception Creek, 30 ft. high, course NW.
- Ascend 100 ft. over NE. slope.
