## CHAINS

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock and cedar.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron, hazel, chinquapin  
and second growth fir.

N.0\*01'W., bet. secs. 25 and 26.

Over mountainous land, through heavy green timber and  
dense undergrowth.

.10 Small spur, slopes SE.

Ascend 170 ft. over SE. slope.

11.34 Emile trail, bears E. and W.

Top of divide, bet. N. and S. Umpqua Rivers, bears E.  
and W.

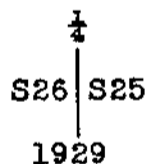
Descend 50 ft. along broken W. slope.

26.65 Spur, slopes NW.

Descend 275 ft. over NE. slope.

39.70 Draw, course NW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked



from which,

A fir, 26 ins. in diam., bears S.70\*E., 60 lks.

dist.; marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 25 B T

A fir, 30 ins. in diam., bears S.60\*W., 26 lks.

dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 26 B T

Descend 105 ft. over N. slope.

46.70 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course W.

Ascend 130 ft. over SW. slope.

59.10 Top of ascent, bears E. and W.

Descend 260 ft. over N slope.

64.55 Top of bluff, 40 ft. high, bears SE. and NW., faces NE.
