

Subdivisions, T. 27 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

A fir, 40 ins, in diam,, bears S.39*W., 30 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 23 B T

A fir, 34 ins, in diam., bears N.70*W., 87 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 14 B T

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, pine, fir and hemlock.

Undergrowth, chinquapin, rhododendron and vinemaple.

S.89*45'E. on a random line bet. secs. 13 and 24.

40.00 Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.

80.16 Intersect the E. bdy. of the Tp., 10 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, hereinbefore described.

Thence

N.89*41'W., on a true line bet. secs. 13 and 24.

Over mountainous land, through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 105 ft. over broken NE. slope.

1.30 Draw, course NE.

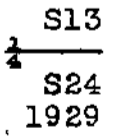
5.30 Mud Lake Way Trail, bears NE. and SW.

10.40 Draw, course N.

17.60 Top of large spur, slopes NW.

Descend 312 ft. over SW. slope.

40.08 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 14 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, supported in a mound of stone 5 ft. base, 1 ft. high, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A cedar, 30 ins. in diam., bears N.28*W., 60 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 13 B T
