Descend 155 ft. over NE. slope.
- 70.10 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course E.  
Ascend 50 ft. over SE. slope.
- 73.10 Small spur, slopes E.  
Descend 50 ft. over NE. slope.
- 79.20 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course SE.  
Ascend 75 ft. over S. slope.
