Land; mountainous.

Soil; loose, coarse, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, and pine;

Undergrowth; rhododendron, huckleberry, chinquapin, and
vinemaple.

iron post, 2 ins. diam., 9 ins. above ground, firmly
set, with brass cap marked
